Bluestem Banjo String Spacing Guide

Printing the guide:

Measurements listed will be accurate if the outline border measures 7" by 9" as printed. It may be necessary to specify certain print options such as "Fit To Page", etc. for your particular printer to print the border box to the correct dimension. You can still use a guide that isn't printed to the exact size, simply measure the spacing desired.

To use:

Find the spacing you need and fold on the dotted line. Do verify the measurement and re-fold slightly lower or higher to achieve the dimension you want.

The string centers can now be directly transferred to the nut, bridge, or tailpiece location as needed.

Note:

I have several of these types of guides that I developed for my own use, and find them very useful. I keep them handy in the shop and reach for them often.

I'm sure you'll do likewise if you give them a try. Keep a copy on your computer and print a fresh one out when you find your old one getting a bit too shop-worn.
