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TAILPIECE FOR A BANJO

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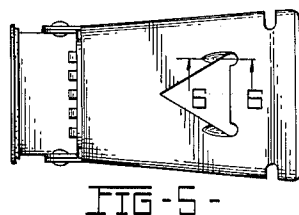
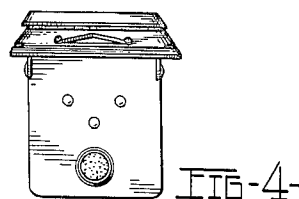
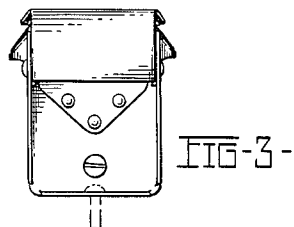
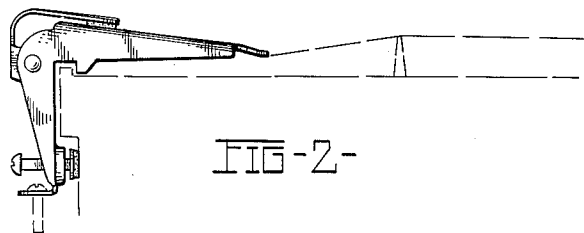
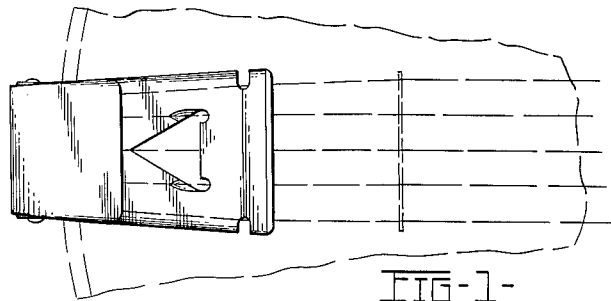


FIGURE 1 is a plan view of a tailpiece for a banjo showing my new design;

FIGURE 2 is a side elevation of the tailpiece of FIGURE 1;

FIGURE 3 is an elevational view of the left or front end of the tailpiece as shown in FIGURE 2;

FIGURE 4 is an elevational view illustrating the right or rear end of the tailpiece;

FIGURE 5 is a plan view like that of FIGURE 1 but with the hinged cover of the string posts swung to open position; and

FIGURE 6 is a section taken on the line 6—6 of FIGURE 5 to bring out more clearly the contour of that portion of the tailpiece.

The broken line showing of a portion of a banjo in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purpose only.
