



Banjo Clog as played by Dock Boggs

Some notes on "Banjo Clog":

Like all of Dock's tunes, the right-hand fingering is simple:

Thumb on the 5th, 4th and 3rd strings Index on the 2nd string Middle finger on the 1st string

No exceptions on this tune.

Heavily accent the note played by the thumb on the 1 of each measure.

When played as a roll (as opposed to the pinches), the final note of each measure — played on the 2nd string by the index finger — is barely audible.

End the tune on the high C chord at the 12th fret.
