
## Little Jimmy's Easy Guitar Melodys By Ear

All of the songs below are in a low octive of the key of C (no sharps or flats) and are played in the first position. Try playing them by ear by using the three starter notes listed for each song. Each song uses only the notes on the above fretboard highlighted in RED. Use your middle finger for the notes on the second fret and your ring finger for the notes on the third fret.

Easy Songs to Play by Ear:

The Melody of each song starts with these three notes and use the RED notes on the above fretboard.

Fourth string, third fret F Fourth string, open D


