


Little Jimmy's Easy Guitar Melodys By Ear

...you figure out the rest!




All of the songs below are in a low octave of the key of C (no sharps or flats) and are played in the first position. Try playing them by ear by using the three starter notes listed for each song. Each song uses only the notes on the above fretboard highlighted in **RED**. Use your middle finger for the notes on the second fret and your ring finger for the notes on the third fret.

Easy Songs to Play by Ear:

The Melody of each song starts with these three notes and use the **RED** notes on the above fretboard.

| 4. Cindy, Cindy | Third string, open G | Third string, second fret A | Third string, open G |



Now try playing the Melody of these songs one octave higher. Use the **RED** notes on the above fretboard.

| 4. Cindy, Cindy | First string, third fret g | First string, fifth fret a | First string, third fret g |
